



## **African Healthcare Workers Association of Colorado (AHWAC) Bylaws**

### **Article I – Name**

The name of this organization shall be the African Healthcare Workers Association of Colorado (AHWAC).

### **Article II – Purpose**

To promote unity, professional growth, cultural competence, and public health engagement among African healthcare workers in Colorado.

### **Article III – Membership**

Membership shall be open to all individuals of African descent and allies who work or study in any healthcare-related field in Colorado.

### **Article IV – Officers**

The officers of AHWAC shall include the Founder & President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and other officers as determined by the Executive Board.

### **Article V – Meetings**

Regular meetings shall be held quarterly, with an annual general meeting in December of each year.

### **Article VI – Committees**

Standing committees shall include Membership, Finance, Program & Events, and Community Outreach.

### **Article VII – Finances**

All funds shall be managed responsibly under the oversight of the Treasurer and approved by the Executive Board.

### **Article VIII – Amendments**

A two-thirds majority vote of members present at any regular or special meeting may amend these bylaws.
